CARDBOARD BOAT RULES

- 1. Only corrugated cardboard may be used. It can be of any thickness but must not be bonded to any other material such as vinyl.
- 2. Wood, metal, Styrofoam, or other materials that would aid in floatation or make the hull ridged are prohibited. This restriction applies to the keel, ribs, transom, hull, etc.
- 3. No material such as Styrofoam, or rubber inflation devices may be used to provide "buoyancy" or maintain floatation. No sandbags or similar materials may be used for ballast.
- 4. Hulls may be painted with any one-part paint. No epoxy glues, fiberglass resins, or multi part paint or varnish may be used.
- 5. Joints and seams may be glued and/or taped. Duct tape, contact cement, rubber cement, or construction adhesive may be used. No nails, metal fasteners, or wooden fasteners may be used including staples.
- 6. Design is builders Choice. Decorations may be made from any material but must not be used to reinforce the structure of the boat.
- 7. No boat will be allowed to leave the starting area unless all persons on board are wearing a personal floatation Device (PFD). Participants will provide their own PFDs and paddles.
- 8. Best Boat Presentation will be determined by the number of votes cast for each boat. Votes may be purchased for One dollar per vote. Boats must race to be eligible for best presentation.
- 9. All entrants must ensure that their portion of the pit area has been cleaned prior to departure on Race day. All boats must be removed from the club or cut apart and placed in trash containers.
